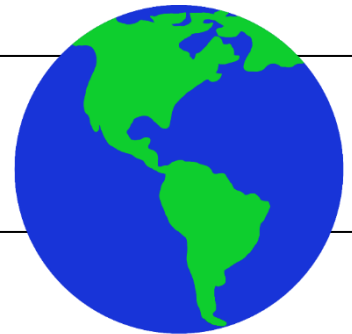

Isolation/Quarantine Recommendations

- Infected with COVID: + test, +/- symptoms
 - Old recommendation: isolate x 10 days
 - New recommendation:
 - » isolate x 5 days
 - » If symptoms resolving & no fever, mask 5 more days
 - » No further testing needed after initial diagnostic test
- Exposed to COVID, but no symptoms:
 - Old rec: quarantine for 7-14 days
 - New rec:
 - » mRNA vaccine x2 plus booster: no quarantine; mask x 10 d
 - » All others: quarantine x 5 days, mask next 5 days
 - » If symptoms, begin isolation and get tested. If +, go to "Infected" line



The CDC has revised guidelines, these are the same guidelines we've used regarding transports. If you've been exposed to COVID please use these recommendations to decide if you should continue with your assignments or not. Of course, if you feel uncomfortable or ill please let us know right away so your transports can be reassigned.
