Other program information you may find interesting...

In 2021, January through October **56 new client applications** have been received. Of those 54 were approved for service. In addition, another **12** one-time transport applications have been received and approved.

Two new volunteers have joined us! Please welcome Joyce Dunlap and Marjorie Morrison, we're happy to have you!

Wheels for Wellness is currently serving **62 unduplicated clients**, which is down from the average of 100 per year.

COVID protocol

I believe we all thought that by this time things would be getting better and back to normal. As the pandemic continues, concerns for driver and client safety remain an issue.

A letter will be going out to all clients asking them to *voluntarily* disclose their vaccination status.

When scheduling there will be a new column on the list indicating if the client has been vaccinated, not vaccinated or declined to answer.

I still encourage you to wear your mask and sanitize frequently touched surfaces and if it's a nice day open your window.
